




Port Hedland Voluntary Buy-Back Scheme

Update to the Port Hedland Industries Council Community Industry Forum (CIF)






Letters have been issued from the Minister for Ports which do the following:

- set out how the Port Hedland Voluntary Buy-Back Scheme will operate, referencing the principles announced in June 2020
- note that Pilbara Ports Authority has been appointed as the PHVBS administrator and facilitator of the proposed Maritime Precinct development
- officially make public the chosen name for our wholly owned subsidiary: Hedland Maritime Initiative Pty Ltd (HMI)

Enclosed with the letter are:


- a contact details form for residential property owners eligible for the PHVBS, which also includes a brief survey gauging interest in the Scheme; and
