



Pilbara Supply Chain – prior to Direct Shipping.

- Materials supplying industry in the Pilbara originate from all over the world.
- Any materials currently shipped in containers that supply the Pilbara are all shipped to Fremantle.
- These are all unpacked and trucked North to the Pilbara, often via Distribution Centres which creates ADDITIONAL HANDLING at HIGHER COSTS, ADDING to LANDED COSTS of GOODS/SUPPLIES/MATERIALS landed in Pilbara.





The ANL Pilbara Connection

- Connecting the power of our global network.
- Frequency of call at Port Hedland: 20 days (initially). Alternate call on PAX service with a dedicated vessel
- Rotation: Singapore → Darwin-Port Hedland (Pilbara) → Dili → Singapore
- OUR EXTENSIVE GLOBAL NETWORK -Connections to <u>over 420 ports</u> throughout the globe via the transhipment hub in Singapore
- Seamless port to port (or door to door) shipments – same container / same Bill of Lading.
- Accepting containerised 20'/40' STANDARD, FLAT RACKS & OPEN TOPS (IN GUAGE/OOG). Our own fleet of equipment.
- Potential expansion to other Pilbara ports
- Opportunities for exports from the region.


