- ▶ To provide a place of safety and recreation for visiting seafarers.

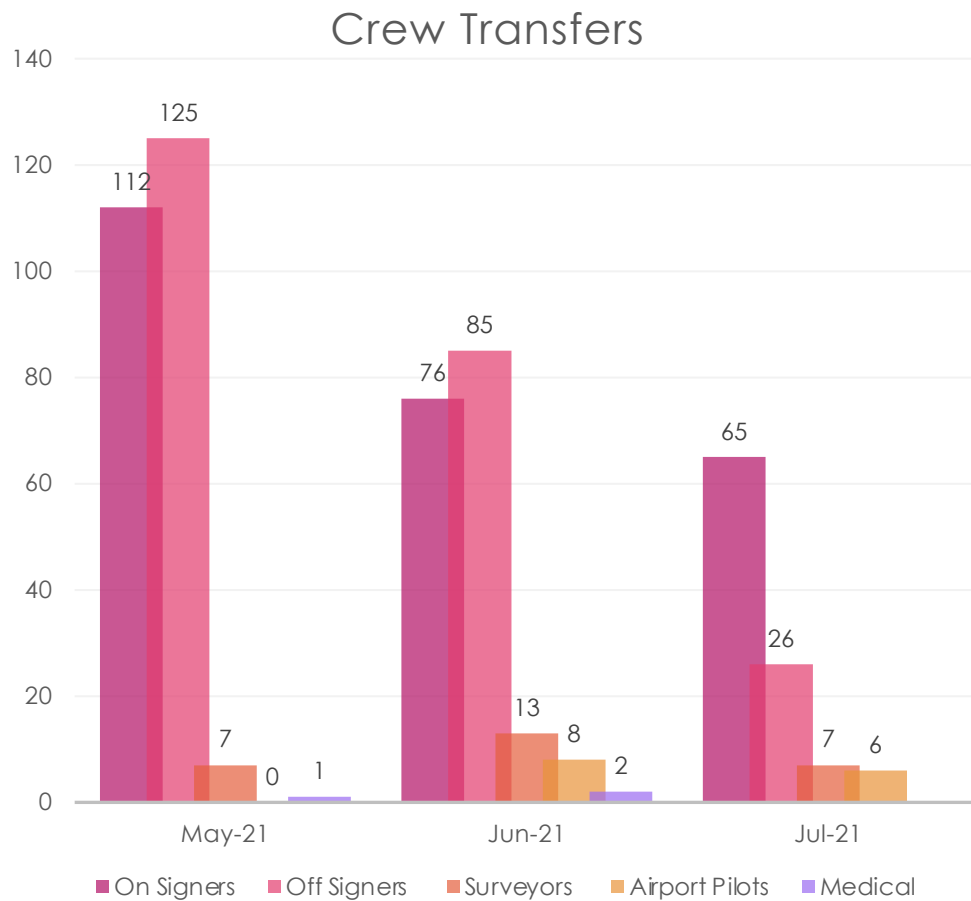

COVID – 19 and PHSC PIVOT

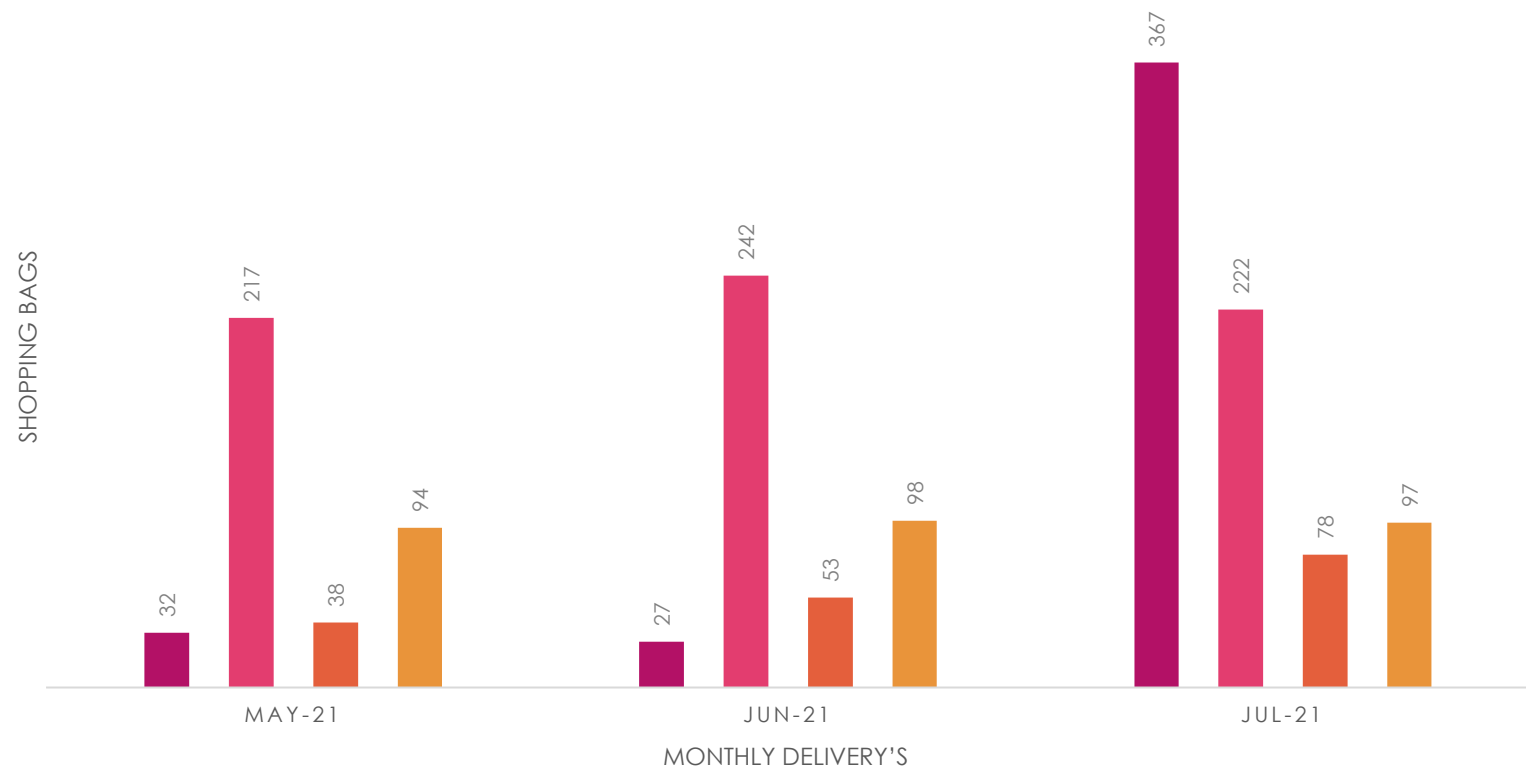
- ▶ Port industry continued supporting the Centre enabling us to pivot and make changes to the delivery of services to Seafarers.
