Shooting Stars is an education engagement program for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander girls and young women.

This culturally responsive program is predominantly delivered by Aboriginal women, who walk alongside Shooting Stars participants throughout their schooling journeys.

Working in collaboration with host schools across Western and South Australia, the team offers advocacy, support and guidance to ensure participants are empowered to make informed decisions and drive their own futures. The program builds confidence, cultural identity, positive relationships, and general wellbeing.
