2023 air monitoring results

- April June 2023 Katestone report finalised no exceedances in this period
- One exceedance when the 24-hour average concentration of PM10 was above 70 μg/m³ at Taplin as previously reported

Pest program - Greater Port Hedland Vertebrate Pest Management Program (VPMP)

- Second 2023 control event 16 to 30 August –
 14 days.
 - 15 feral cats
 - 3 foxes
- VPMP Fact Sheet is now available on our website.

State-Wide Array Surveillance Program (SWASP)

- 2023 Winter soak commenced in July
- No invasive pests requiring action detected


