2025 air monitoring results

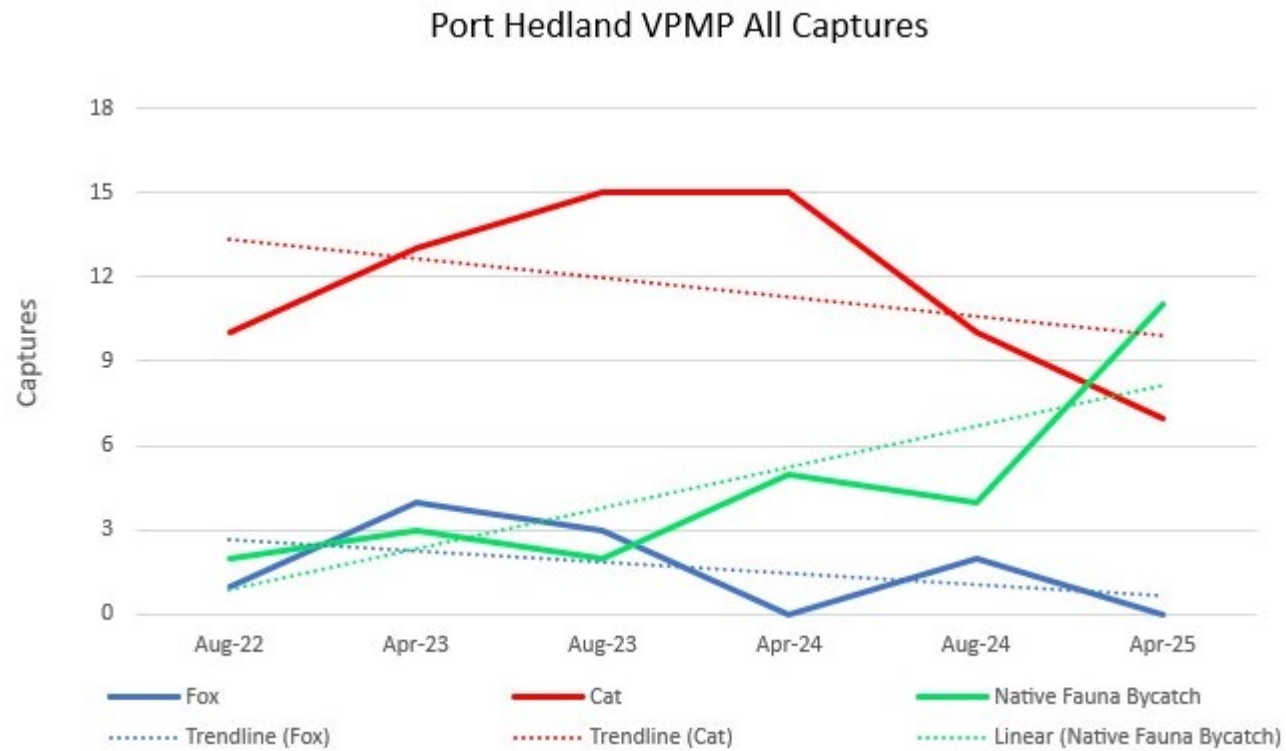
- One exceedance of the 24-hour average PM10 in January – March 2025 verified by Katestone.

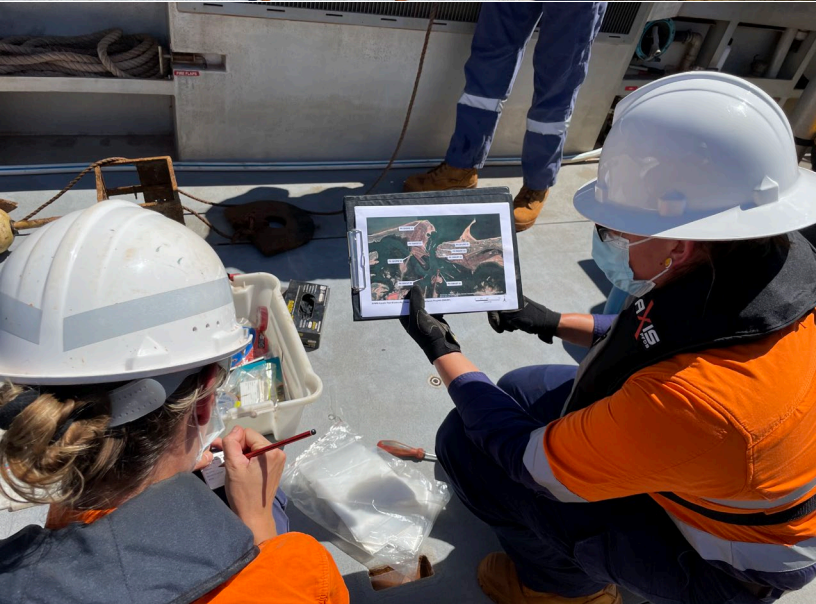
DWER air network management commenced 1 Jan 2022

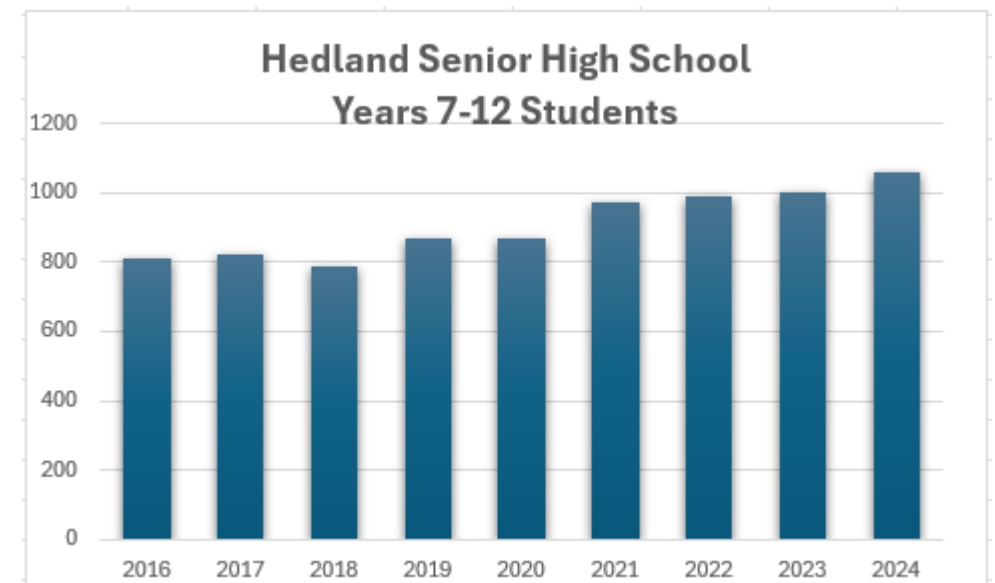
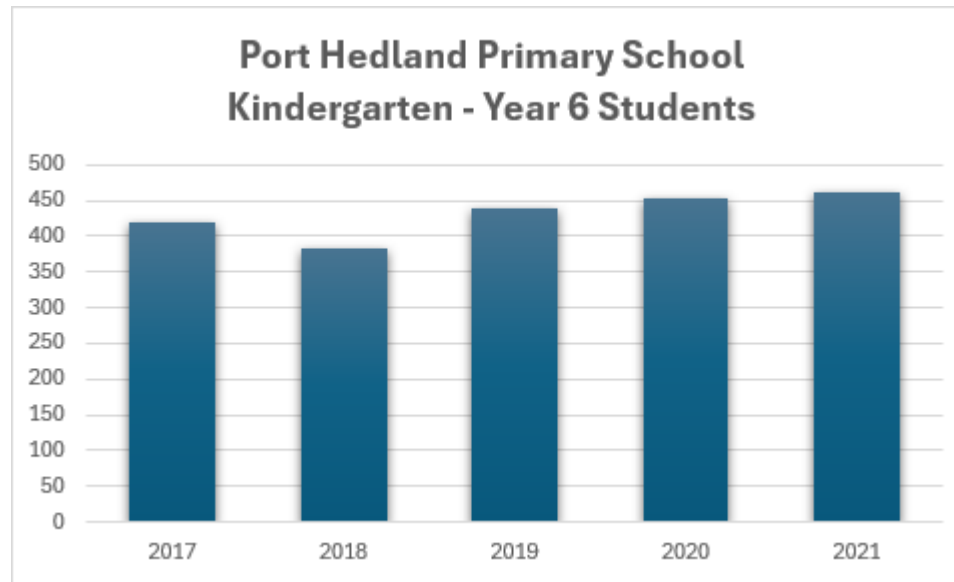
