

2025 Calendar year air monitoring results

- Six exceedances of the 24-hour average PM10 in January – December 2025 verified by Katestone.
- All exceedances have background contribution.
- Four exceedances over 70 µg/m³ had industry contribution.
- Two were natural/regional events.





DWER air network management commenced 1 Jan 2022
